### ***Scholarships for High School Seniors 2012 . . . Write a Winning Essay***

High school seniors, juniors and students currently registered at post-secondary institutions can write an essay to qualify for the B. Davis Scholarship. The deadline to apply for the \$1,000 award is May 28, 2012.

There is no age requirement for this non-academic scholarship. Be sure, however, to include your name, where you are currently attending school, and what your future academic plans are. Please do not send transcripts or letters of recommendation at this time.

An essay of less than 1,000 words is required on a topic designated on the website. The current essay topic is to discuss how your education has contributed to who you are today and how it will affect who you will become. Your submissions must be sent via email at [awards@studentawardsearch.com](mailto:awards@studentawardsearch.com).

### ***Scholarships for High School Seniors 2012 . . . Are You a Vegan?***

Are you a vegetarian who promotes the lifestyle?
